

# RECOMMENDED TOOL LIST

It will be necessary to acquire tool and equipment donations, as well as having some volunteers bring their own tools for your community build playground project. It is critical that all tools be labeled to ensure they are not lost. We suggest that you organize a tool check in and check out area to ensure all needed tools are available to your construction volunteers. Burke provides a hardware packet that includes special wrenches, bits and other hardware for the installation of the playground equipment. Your installation supervisor can provide a list of needed tools for build day.
